- decommissioning from masts; and
- rates recovery.

It is to be noted that Police Scotland will be responsible for sending licence and any other invoices (rates, electricity, track recharges etc.) to Sharers and for debt recovery of these invoices (which is not in scope in relation to the Contract).

During the period of the Contract, the Authority and Police Scotland intend to carry out a Strategic Review in relation to the future delivery model in relation to the mast portfolio.
