The Enforcement and Markets Oversight division within the FCA has approximately 400 employees, not including contractors, that use the eDiscovery software, which currently stores around 160 million documents. Digital evidence review and analysis are core capabilities required to support regulatory, civil and criminal case work. The quality of these capabilities has a direct impact on the FCA's ability to undertake effective and efficient enforcement action and to assist the FCA with effective credible deterrence.
