The service that arise from this framework will involve the supplier holding material that has been assigned a protective marking under the Government Security Classifications Scheme (April 2014) of OFFICIAL/SENSITIVE. Bidders will be required to implement their solution in accordance with the Enforcement Services Schedule, "Security Requirement and Plan", to meet Enforcement Services requirements.
