II.2.4) Description of the procurement

NPC is a contracting authority under regulation 2 of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015, and a central purchasing body under regulation 37 of those Regulations.

NPC is administered by M3Housing Ltd on behalf of the NHMF.

NPC has been tasked with establishing multi supplier frameworks at regional, sub-regional and local authority level to provide maintenance and Improvement services to the social housing stock of its members. The scope of the individual frameworks is being developed, and NPC wants to engage with the market in order to support both the development of the framework and procurement strategies.
