- the Museum Shop and Admissions area
- an area known as the 'Railway Siding' - a timber-clad, tin-roofed entrance following the line of the original railway
- the Kiln Floor, an area in front of the 19th century No.1 Kilns

A 2022 Condition Survey of the Bagging Shed confirmed that roof and wall repairs, along with urgent stabilisation work are required in the next two years to protect the historic wooden structure and prevent collapse.
