Library staff would work in partnership with carer services to provide greet and meet low level support and information needs of carers. The Carers service would have provided ongoing training and support to the library staff to build their skills and capacity in supporting carers with low level needs. Individual confidential one to one space would be available within each library to offer a suitable place to communicate with carers. The libraries would offer a flexible space for small carers groups to meet or provide information and guidance sessions on a group basis
