This is a Prior Information Notice (PIN) to inform the market of an upcoming procurement. The procurement itself is not as yet 'live'.

NHS South-East London Integrated Care Board (NHS SEL ICB) currently commissions one Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) in the Greenwich area which is co-located within the Emergency Department (ED) at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QEH), Woolwich, London SE18.

The Procurement and Contracting Hub (PCH), hosted by NHS North-East London Integrated Care Board, is managing this market engagement exercise on behalf of NHS SEL ICB ('The Authority').

This contract is due to expire on 31st March 2023 and the ICB's current intention is to launch a procurement by end of September / early October 2022 to re-procure the contract with a service start date of 1st April 2023. It is expected that the contract will be procured with a term of no less than 7 years (3 years, with an option to extend for 2 years and a further option to extend for additional 2 years) and based on the NHS Standard Contract terms and conditions. The indicative value for the total proposed contract is £ 5,588,767 per annum (£39,121,369 over 7 years).
