single access point; either using a single Tier 1 supplier, a consortium of suppliers, or Special

Procurement Vehicle (SPV).

We are encouraging a consortium bid that can be made up of many small suppliers - all suppliers/producers will need to meet the minimum technical, ethical and policy requirements and

Government buying standards for food.

Our initial contract value is estimated to attract £100 million worth of spend over the 4-year (2 + 1

+1) contract period, which is a small proportion of the annual £2.1 billion public sector food spend.
