The supply of a dilapidation program for the class 458/5 to ensure the fleet is returned, as best as possible, to its original state with minimal defects. Internal records shall be kept, and signature trail of works completed as well as completing work orders. Staff must have in depth technical knowledge of both mechanical and electrical systems for the Class 458 Fleet specifically, as this is a unique fleet of trains maintained and operated by South Western Railway.
