The aim of the service is to provide a comprehensive quality service of assessment, supply and maintenance/repair of wheelchairs and associated seating equipment for users who are registered with a GP in NWL ICB encompassing the following elements:

1. Equipment provision and maintenance
2. Repairs
3. Planned preventative maintenance (PPM) of powered and Manual chairs
4. Staffing

The Service will provide:

- Assessment, prescription and provision of manual and powered wheelchairs, and associated postural accessories;
- Repair and maintenance services; and
- Rehabilitation engineering services
