The catering contract being offered will commence on 1 August 2022 for an initial period of three years, concluding on 31 July 2025, and will be offered on a guaranteed performance basis, with a service on each of the 190 full academic days and by agreement for the 5 inset days.

West Park School catering aims:

- •To ensure that the whole school community understands the importance of a nutritionally balanced diet in promoting health and wellbeing.
- •To offer pupils and staff a range of value for money options, suitable for all customer's budgets to maximise uptake of the catering service.
- •To stimulate pupil interest in the service through promotions, variety, new foods and links between to the curriculum.

The School has had the same catering contractor for a significant number of years and this is the first time the contract has been placed at competitive tender for over 5 years.

Annual catering revenue for the year ending 31 July 2019 was £347,546. (Last full year trading pre-Covid) The successful contractor is expected to have a local operational presence, as specialist caterers in the Secondary School sector.

The contract covers the scope for the provision of catering services within the School, which currently includes breakfast, morning break, lunch, all hospitality and free issue

requirements. Free school meals and hospitality will be charged at cost price, based on consumption.

The School expects the successful contractor to enable the continued development of catering through the provision of an innovative, healthy food service, prepared on-site.
