Supply of school transport services for the 2025-26 academic year to transport 258 students from the Goonhavern/Perranporth area of Cornwall to Penair School (TR1 1TN).

The service is required from 03/09/2025 until 17/07/2026 during term time only and will not be required on INSET days and bank holidays. There is the possibility of a contract extension until 16th July 2027.
