Southampton City Council were seeking bids for an Independent Peer Support Service (Substance Use Disorder Services) initially scoping, and consulting with existing local support and recovery communities with the aim of designing a service model, to be agreed and implemented, for delivery of high-quality, co-produced peer support services to reduce the harm caused by drugs and alcohol and to support the recovery of people with substance use disorders.

The service would have:

- Supported harm reduction and recovery across the City
- Improved the health and wellbeing of adults with alcohol and drug dependency disorders
- Increased the number of people successfully reducing their alcohol and/or drug use, including an increase in the number of people becoming alcohol and/or drug free
- Reduced the harm and mortality associated with alcohol and drug use and dependency
- Reduced the stigma of accessing substance use services including increasing access for alcohol users
- Reduced health inequalities in relation to substance use
