Families First is designed to improve outcomes for children, young people and families. It places an emphasis on early intervention, prevention, and providing support for whole families, rather than individuals. Families First is one grant within the Children and Communities Grant along with others such as Flying Start, Supporting People and Communities First. The contract is aimed at three distinct areas – Parenting (1), Young People (2) and Disability (3). Therefore the tender is structured into three lots covering each area respectively. Bidders may bid for any number of lots.

Close work with Flying Start is crucial to plan appropriate and tailored support for families, coordinated by a single practitioner or volunteer. For instance, this is especially important in facilitating smooth transitions for families as children move into school and families with children of different ages. Parenting is at the core of the work of Families First and this is reflected in the higher contract value of this lot.
