The lifetime value of this DPS will increase to £50m for the following reasons: • Significant rise in regional transport requirements - especially for young people with special educational needs (SEN) and refugees who are being hosted in the local community. • Economic and political factors which have led to rising fuel costs, driver and passenger assistant shortages, increased wages, vehicle and parts shortages / delays. This means that new contracts are notably higher value than we have seen previously and so overall value has been adjusted to allow for continued awards during this DPS.
