The Council has an ambitious Extra Care Programme and Extra Care schemes are a fundamental and growing component of our service, enabling people with high levels of support needs to live in the community but with care support on site. We currently commission care and support services in 19 Extra Care Housing (ECH) schemes containing over 800 flats.

We plan to tender contracts for 18 Extra Care Schemes and 2 new schemes over the next 2 years. Our aim is that Extra Care schemes will increasingly be able to accommodate people with more complex care needs, including those with sensory or cognitive impairments, reducing the need for them to transition to residential or nursing care at a later stage. We also want to explore different models of care delivery that will both support our prevention agenda and can evolve to meet the changing needs of people living in schemes.
