-Trans nasal endoscopy

-Flexible sigmoidoscopy

-Colonoscopy

The service will be delivered from a site within the Ipswich and East Suffolk locality.

The commissioners are looking to establish a contract for three (3) years with a potential extension period of up to two (2) years.

II.2.4) Description of the procurement

The aim of this procurement is to establish a Community Endoscopy Service within the NHS Suffolk and North East Essex Integrated Care Board (ICB) locality.

The provider will deliver a community endoscopy service for patients who are referred by their GP. The provider must ensure that the service is planned and delivered in consultation with the commissioners, local acute gastroenterology services and GP practices.

The following diagnostic investigations will be delivered:

-Oesophago-gastro duodenoscopy (OGD)

-Trans nasal endoscopy

-Flexible sigmoidoscopy

-Colonoscopy

The service will be delivered from a site within the Ipswich and East Suffolk locality.

The contract will be for a term of 36 months (three years), with the possibility of extending the term for a period of 24 additional months (two years) beyond the initial contracted duration by agreement between the Authority and the Provider. The contract will be activity-based and will have an indicative activity plan and agreed tariffs.

The anticipated aggregate contract value is £14,604,075. across the potential 5 years, but this is an indicative figure based on indicative activity.

This notice is to inform providers of the release of documentation to initiate a competitive process to secure a Provider(s) to deliver this service.
