The roles do not lend themselves to a 'pool of different medics' doing the work on a 'who is available' basisas the Medical Advisers actively contribute and are instrumental to the wider occupational health work of HSE. They play a key role in governance and delivering the 'clinical lead' function, including taking the leadon regulatory aspects of medical and health work, scientific and research activity or revalidation and appraisal aspects of HSE's medical activity. This integrated approach of maintaining hands-on clinical knowledge coupled to regulatory knowledge is vital for HSE to deliver its role and act as the government's chief occupational healthadviser.
