We will also provide you with the most up to date version of our Statement of Requirements for your review prior to the session.

Please note that this is not an opportunity to provide a proposal or quotation to the Contracting Authority, or to try and sell your product. The purpose of this exercise is purely to test the market, gain feedback and input into our final service definitions and tender documentation. UKRI will consider information and responses received as part of the market consultation to help inform UKRI specification and further decision making in relation to the planning and conduct of the proposed procurement. Outputs from the meetings will be shared with other potential suppliers that registered their interest and will form part of the final tender documentation.

The proposed funding range (to cover professional services days and licensing for the term of the contract for both the IGA and AM SAAS solutions) is between £1.2m and £1.8m (inclusive of VAT). Suppliers feedback on the estimated budget would also be welcomed.
