The STW system are exploring the re-procurement of CAMHS locally. The provider of CAMHS will play a key role working with patients, clinicians, and other partners, to implement the mental health transformation across Shropshire, Telford and Wrekin. The provider will be an integral part of the overall programme governance structure working with the mental health collaborative for the delivery of the CYP Mental Health targets and indicators.

The provider will need a comprehensive mental health offer that will include:

- Single point of access
- 24/7 crisis and home treatment
- Eating disorders including ARFID
- Mental health support in Schools
- Meeting access targets
- Reducing waiting lists

The service will also offer a neurodevelopmental (ND) assessment and diagnosis for
