The value in II.1.5 is an indicative value over the lifetime of the framework (4 years).

Bidders will be required to implement their solution in accordance with the Framework Agreement Schedule, "Security Requirement and Plan", to meet Framework Agreement requirements. This will be released at the ITT stage.
