The overall target requirement for the project is 816 participants within an allocated budget of £447,513 (excluding VAT), over 3 years from January 2025 to December 2027.

The PEACEPLUS Employability – Language Up Belfast forms parts of the Belfast PEACEPLUS Local Community Action Plan, which is supported by PEACEPLUS, a programme managed by the Special EU Programmes Body (SEUPB).
