- To summarise key findings, recommendations and themes from all five HNAs and to incorporate reviews/findings (already undertaken), of South West criminal justice services that fall outside of L&D and Reconnect, specifically, Court Healthcare and MHTRs
- To facilitate a better understanding of the need and likely demand for integrated Non-

custodial services

- To support commissioners to prioritise resources
- To assist decision makers in the maintaining, planning and future improvement of services which address need, efficiency and effectiveness
