The scheme entails:- Single carriageway road stretching from Church Lane to the north, south for a distance of 3.9km;- Provision of three new roundabouts and two new junction arrangements;- Two new overbridges, one vehicular and one pedestrian;- A new 450m single carriageway link into the town from the bypass;- The contract will include ancillary works such as provision for non-motorised users, necessary realignment of the existing local road and Public Right of Way network and the provision of environmental and ecological mitigation measures.
