- Budgeting and Finance Management
- Self-help and domestic skills

- What support services they are entitled to and can access
- How to look after a property, and sustain a tenancy
- Support in finding education and employment opportunities
- Finding and securing 'Move-On' accommodation

The new contract is to run for a period of 4 years (2+1+1) commencing on the 3rd July 2023

The Service will need to consider TUPE arrangements for employees who are currently delivering the service.
