Ayrshire and Arran Health Board (more commonly known as NHS Ayrshire and Arran) ("NHS Ayrshire and Arran") ("the Health Board") is seeking expressions of interest from any parties interested in providing primary medical services to patients in Galston, Newmilns, Darvel, Hurlford, Waterside, Moscow, Auchencloigh, Crookedholm and Priestland.
