- Where a Person may need support at home that is not considered 'typical' homecare. The Person might be able to meet their own personal care needs, but have additional needs outside of the home or living independently.

Floating support:

- This might include a support worker who delivers day-to-day support to a group of People living in an area.
- It may also include someone who needs to be specially trained and have an understanding of a specific People's (i.e. client group's) needs.
- It may be location based or building based, but can include a number of different People being supported to achieve specific outcomes.
