Highley (WV16 6) is a rurally isolated large village in South Shropshire, 7.5 miles to the south of Bridgnorth with a population of 3,735 people.

The current registered practice population is 3,286. The current staff are 2 GPs, 2 Nurses, 2

Direct patient care and 4 Admin.

The contract value for a 12 month period is £368,291 for Global sum or £434,985 inc QOF and LCS based on 2022/23 figures.
