These features will allow HCC to use and analyse data, produce reports, and league tables with more granular data to inform decision making.

Please note, there is a maximum annual budget cap of £235,000.00 based on current number of meters (1,719). Tenderers will be excluded from the procurement process if the

above stated maximum is exceeded.
