The total area maintained may increase or decrease by approximately 10-20% depending on future acquisition or disposal of university land or buildings.

The frequency and volume of service delivery (e.g. grass cutting, hedge trimming, path maintenance) may vary by approximately \pm 15% due to seasonal factors, evolving site use, or sustainability priorities.

The University may require additional one-off services such as storm damage clearance or event-related support, which may increase the annual value of the contract by up to 10% in any given year.
