Yag laser capsulotomy is a simple, safe laser treatment to improve eyesight if some fogging recurs after cataract surgery because of lense clouding.

Oculoplastics covers conditions affecting displacement of the eyelids, tumours of the eyelids and surrounding areas, lacrimal gland conditions, failure of the tear drainage system, orbital tumours and thyroid eye disease.
