The supplier is required to develop a programme of activity to support local digital skills. The supplier should prioritise engaging Torbay residents facing digital exclusion and ensure delivery can be managed flexibly to those with high or complex needs.

Lot 5 – Tailored support to help people in employment – Sector Pathways:-

The supplier is required to develop a 'Torbay Sector Pathways' that will help improve the overall skills levels across the key sectors listed below.

- Fisheries
- Construction
