The RMDS offers services for Germline and Somatic testing to improve diagnosis, treatment options and management of patients with cancer, haematological conditions and rare genetic disorders. The germline service is divided into Constitutional Cytogenetics and Molecular Genetics, and the somatic service consists of a solid tumour and hematological malignancies section.
