HSE asserts its belief that Sheffield Teaching Hospital is the only economic operator in the EU that is capable of supporting HSE in respect of delivering the service required. The work delivered by physicians to HSE requires a unique combination of both medical expertise (up to date and relevant to real clinical situations through continued medical practice and diagnosis) coupled with a deep understanding of the regulatory and policy aims of the HSE. The roles do not lend themselves to a 'pool of different medics' doing the work on a 'who is available' basis as the Medical Advisers actively contribute and are instrumental to the wider occupational health work of HSE. They play a key role in governance and delivering the 'clinical lead' function, including taking the lead on regulatory aspects of medical and health work, scientific and research activity or revalidation and appraisal aspects of HSE's medical activity. This integrated approach of maintaining hands-on clinical knowledge coupled to regulatory knowledge is vital for HSE to deliver its role and act as the government's chief occupational health adviser
