Swansea Council is seeking to establish market options for the future management of Tir John Landfill Site. The Council currently has a third party managing the site while it finishes off the operational phase and capping and restoration works.

The Council intends to procure a contract to start in 2026 and is seeking to understand the market for various contract options and lengths of contract.

Areas which require management include:

- Day to day management of the landfill site in accordance with environmental permits subject to an agreed split of roles and responsibilities with the Council

- Undertake environmental monitoring and reporting in accordance with the permit

- Undertake management of the landfill gas field and landfill gas generating plant. This may also include trading of electricity and ROCS etc. to achieve the highest income
