### **Description**

The Welsh Blood Service (WBS) is an All Wales Service collecting voluntary, non-remunerated blood donations from the public. These donations are processed and tested before distribution to hospitals where they support patient care.

The WBS is a division of Velindre University NHS Trust. A Senior Leadership Team supports the Divisional Director of the WBS and the WBS is authorised and licenced by the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency, who audit the organisation at defined periods.

The WBS Transport Department operates a large fleet of vehicles as part of the organisation's activities in the collection, testing and distribution of blood and blood products to its customer hospitals. A proportion of these vehicles are based in North

Wales at two separate locations. It is essential that the WBS service have to necessary maintenance contact in place to ensure that all vehicle's operated and driven by employees are legally compliant with current road transport legislation.
