SCTS require the application to conduct automatic classification by content of records maintained in SCTS' systems of record and paper records. SCTS is seeking a solution that would use a high degree of AI-based automation to automatically classify the records held in SCTS systems with a high degree of confidence and then apply the retention for those records based on the classification. This is a retention system based on 'Content not container'.

SCTS also require the solution to be able to keep logs persistently and create metadata disposal stubs. The high level requirements of the system are laid out below.
