The contract term would be from 1/12/2023-30/11/2024, with the possibility of two 12 months extensions. Contracts with Suppliers will be tariff-based and subject to change, with

no minimum guaranteed value, as the service is activity based). However, the estimated total

spends including reimbursement of the LARC devices, over 3 years is 4,100,000 GBP.

Kent County Council is looking to appoint Suppliers through a Dynamic Purchasing System,

to provide this service. The DPS is for the procurement of social and other services referred

to in Regulation 74 of the Public Contracts Regulations (2015) and as such, the intention is

to use a Light Touch Regime, rather than the full regime described in Regulation 34 (Dynamic Purchasing System).
