The works will mainly comprise replacing a variety of different door and frame materials with external grade composite fire door sets. The locations will include the entrances of flats in residential blocks of flats, within unheated internal communal areas or along their external walkways. NCH policy is to install External Grade Composite Fire door sets in all internal and external locations, compliant with relevant British Standards or European Standards

The estimated Measured Term Contract value will be up to a maximum of 2,500,000 GBP (excl. VAT) for the contract period. If contract extensions are offered these will be for time only. Contract extension will be offered at the discretion of Newport City Homes.
