This approach is considered justified and aligned to the Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014, which states that Public Sector Organisations may award a contract without seeking offers, considering the principles of procurement where relevant. This method of award will mitigate the risk of a gap in delivery of the services, minimising the impact on the supported individuals. This route for award of contract was considered to be in the best of interests of the vulnerable people recieving the service.
