Duties also include maintenance of roadside technology, the provision of traffic management for the contractor, maintenance and incident response activities, and traffic management for others who may be working on the network.

The Contract is due to expire on 31st March 2034 and will be shortened to have a new end date of 6th June 2029, this is in order to align with the procurement process for the next Maintenance & Response contracts.

This means that the term of this Area 10 M&R Contract will be shortened and will have a new end date of 6th June 2029 instead of 31st March 2034. The amended Contract estimated value is £468,270,000.
