The current Ethical Investments Policy states:

It is recommended that there is negative exclusion of investment in companies manufacturing and distributing:

- Alcoholic products;
- Tobacco products; and
- Any products which may be considered in conflict with the Health Board's activities.

Investment is not permitted in companies which have a poor record in human rights and child exploitation or which derive their profits from countries with poor human rights records
