- The standby generators shall be capable of operating on both diesel and HVO fuel types. It is anticipated that HVO fuel shall be used as standard throughout our sites, however, we may require to switch to diesel as required from time to time and the generator sets should allow this.
- Ancillary inspection and reporting services shall be incorporated.
