#### 2. Post health check GP appointments

To develop/use an escalation criteria to identify patients who would benefit from GP intervention following an NHS health check. Where the criteria is met, patients will be offered a GP appointment/s where the following will be undertaken:

- Initiation of treatment
- Stabilisation of treatment
- Health promotion
- 3. Access to complimentary services

To work with other services to ensure that patients have the opportunity to access complimentary services where appropriate.
