Novation Agreement - Supplier Change:

The Authority has agreed to release and discharge Connect Infracore Limited ("Connexin") from the Contract subject to CityFibre Limited agreeing to perform the Contract and be bound by its terms in place of Connexin.

This transfer of responsibilities will result in CityFibre Limited, as part of the CityFibre group, becoming responsible for the continued delivery of the Gigabit Infrastructure Subsidy Contract with effect from the date of the Novation Agreement.

Connexin is a wholly-owned subsidiary of CityFibre Limited.
