#### Option 1

- From August 2026 onwards 20-25 EBD beds to be immediately available for NCC sole use

OR

- From August 2026 onwards 20-25 EBD beds to be incrementally made available/ developed over a 3 year period, at the end of August 2029 having a minimum of 20 beds reserved for NCC sole use.
