WRAP has been in discussion throughout 2025 about the possibility of taking over the project coordinator role whilst seeking reassurance from business funders about continuity of support.

However, as the current agreement terminates at the end of December, this gives WRAP no flexibility over procurement options to maintain continuity in delivery from the beginning of January.

Continuity in delivery is critical taking into account the expert service providers required to deliver the project. If the project cannot offer continuity, these service providers need to secure alternative employment and delivery is impacted as expertise, capacity and relationship holders are forced to leave the project.
