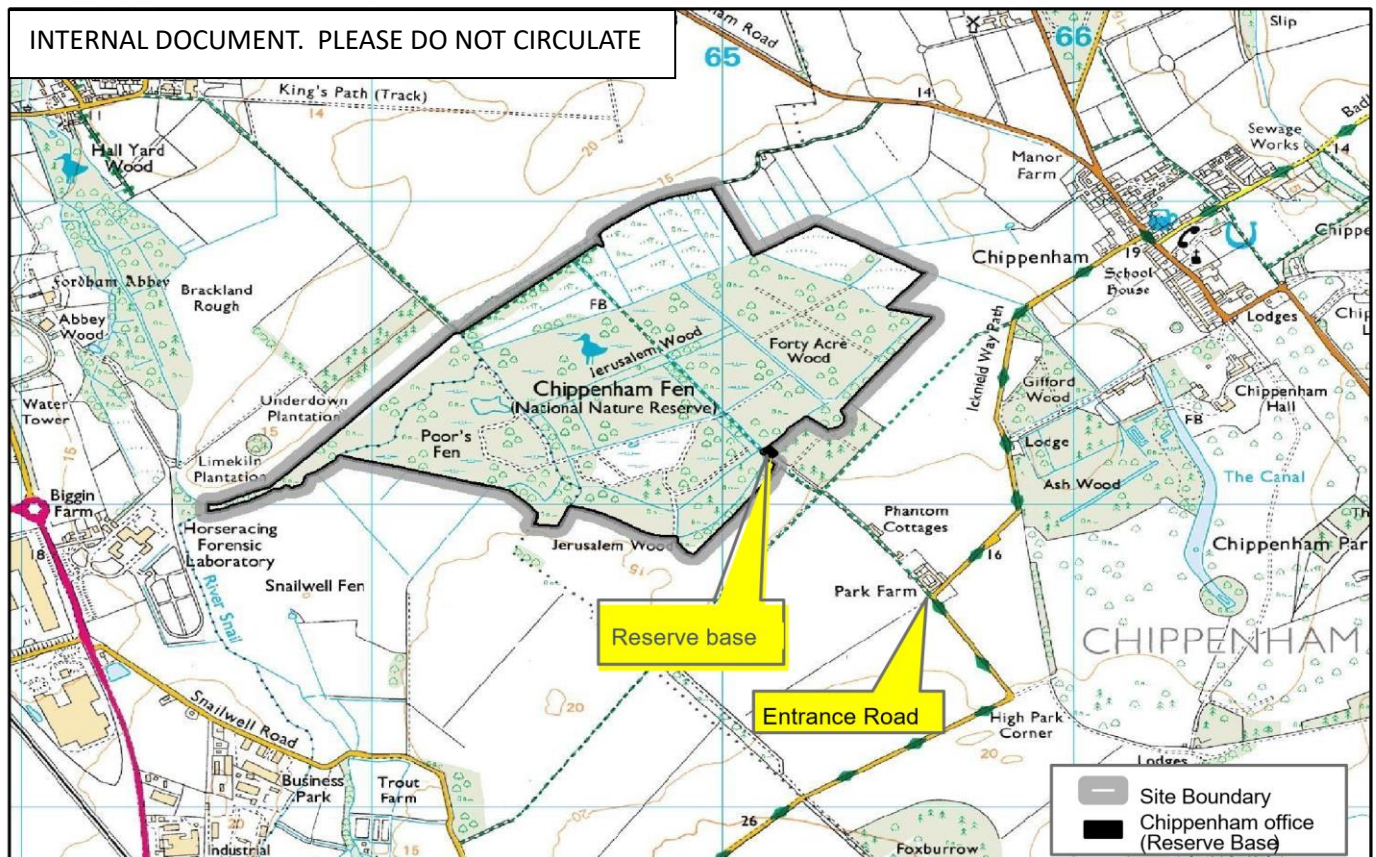


Chippenham Fen National Nature Reserve

- Sat nav use **CB7 5QB** (approximate and will not get you to the NE office).
- What 3 Words: **Rumble.Rave.Landlady**
- Grid ref: **TL 651691**

Chippenham Fen NNR is found close to the village of Chippenham in Cambridgeshire. About 5 miles north of Newmarket. The reserve entrance is through Park Farm, via a gated track. The access is on the Chippenham to Snailwell road.

The entrance is on a dangerous blind corner when approaching from Chippenham. **We advise you drive past Park Farm, toward Snailwell. Turn around in layby on High Park Corner and approach from this direction. So you are not cutting across, into oncoming traffic, on a blind bend.**

Please contact the NNR office to get access through the metal access gate.

Proceed through the working farmyard- **Be Alert to Farm Traffic.**

Continue past the cottages. Please drive very slow, **5 mph**, past our neighbours to reduce noise, dust & mud issues.

Parking is outside the NNR base.
