The provision of Enterprise Architecture Tool to the University of Salford

1.0 Introduction

This document relates to the provision of an Enterprise Architecture Tool to the University of Salford for a 24-month period commencing 27 February 2026.

2.0 Services to be provided

The Enterprise Architecture Tooling company quoting for the provision of an EA Architecture tool, this will include support and training acting as a point of contact for the duration of application license.

The requirements described within this document will be delivered using the Enterprise Architecture tool and the ability of the application to meet architecture requirements in their entirety is the full responsibility of the quoting company.

The quoting company shall provide an average of 2.5 days of the EA Architecture consultants time per month for the duration of the 24-month contract for implementation, enhancement and enrichment of the application.

It is recognised that training and consultancy maybe higher or lower in some months, but the EA Architecture consultants time on the project will not be lower than 60 days over the 24-month period. The EA Architecture tool' capabilities will include the following (note that this list is not exhaustive):

- Development and delivery of Enterprise Architecture tooling training
- Architecture Coverage: Business, Application, Data/Information, Technology/Infrastructure; optional Security Architecture. Cross domain dependency mapping; capability mapping & heat maps.
- Frameworks & Standards: Support for TOGAF/ADM, ArchiMate (latest), BPMN, UML; optional Zachman. Extensible/custom metamodels and viewpoints.
- Repository & Knowledge Management: Central repository; versioning and change history; reusable building blocks; baselining; as is/transition/to be modeling; impact analysis.
- Visualization & Reporting: Rich diagramming; role based views; dashboards; heat maps; dependency, lifecycle, and roadmap visualisations; export to PDF/PNG/PPTX/Excel.
- Road mapping & Transformation: Capability/application/technology roadmaps; time phased planning; scenario and what if analysis; portfolio rationalisation.
- Collaboration: Multiuser concurrency; RBAC views;

The EA Architecture consultants' services will include the following (note that this list is not exhaustive):

- Inception & design artefacts: metamodel, viewpoints, guardrails
- Migration plan and execution report
- Integration configuration and test evidence
- EA operating model and governance pack
- Role based training materials and sessions
- Adoption plan, metrics framework, and first executive dashboard pack
- Knowledge transfer & handover report

3.0 Pricing

The pricing should be expressed as a yearly fee based on the 2.5 days per month detailed at 2.0 (above).

4.0 Evaluation

The quotations received by the University will be evaluated based on a combination of price and demonstrable evidence of how the application meets the requirements detailed in 2.0 (above), within the context of a university environment.
