Update April 2019

The wood is now well established with good growth in the southern half. The paths are clearly delineated and subject to regular mowing.

The ash seedlings forming thick regrowth in the southern part of the wood are affected by ash dieback and will be monitored for survivors annually to ascertain response to disease pressure.
